



### **Code of Practice for Junior Members**

Newton Abbot Fishing Association is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting well being of its members. The Association believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore members are encouraged to be open at all times and share any concerns or complaints that they have about any aspect of the Association with the Coach or Lead Official.

As a member of Newton Abbot Fishing Association, you are expected to abide by the following junior code of practice:

- All members must comply with the rules of Newton Abbot Fishing Association and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable clothing for training and match sessions as agreed with the coach/team leader.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on Association premises or whilst representing the club at competitions
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on Association premises or whilst representing the Association.
